



The work of the Ukrainian artist Oleksa Zakharchuk (born 1929) can be seen for the first time in Britain at the Mall Galleries, SW1 (until 19 April), and at the Arts Club (40 Dover Street, W1, 16-27 April). Zakharchuk graduated from art college in Kharkov in 1950, before transferring to the Kiev Institute of Fine Arts, where he studied for a further seven years. He is known above all for his landscapes, see 'Washerwoman', 1974, above; his paintings can be found in museums in Kiev, Moscow and Odessa.
