

Exchange Direct PLC Sponsors Art Exhibition at the Mall Galleries, London

Exchange Direct PLC co-sponsored an exhibition of the renowned Ukrainian artist, Gregoriy Gordeevich Shyshko (1923 - 1994), at the Mall Galleries, London, between the 4th and 18th March 2001.

The exhibition was organised by Danusha Fine Arts which has specialised in promoting art from the Ukraine since 1992 with over 50 exhibitions being held at galleries, museums and arts centres in London, Edinburgh, Liverpool, Aberdeen, Henley-on-Thames, Windsor, Dumfries, Hawick, Langham and Peebles.

Grygoriy Shyshko was an officially approved and recognised artist of the Soviet Union, who rose to the top of his profession through the "beauty of work in the service of the State." He later branched out to paint poetic landscapes of his native Ukraine.

The launch party on March 7th was attended by many distinguished guests including H.E. The Ambassador of Ukraine to the Court of St

To add to the ambience of the evening, a film crew from the Ukraine had flown over to the UK to do a documentary on London, the exhibition and Exchange Direct PLC.

The exhibition was held in close co-operation with The Chernobyl Relief Foundation in the UK set up by the Embassy of the Ukraine in 1995, and part of the proceeds from the exhibition will be donated to this charity.
